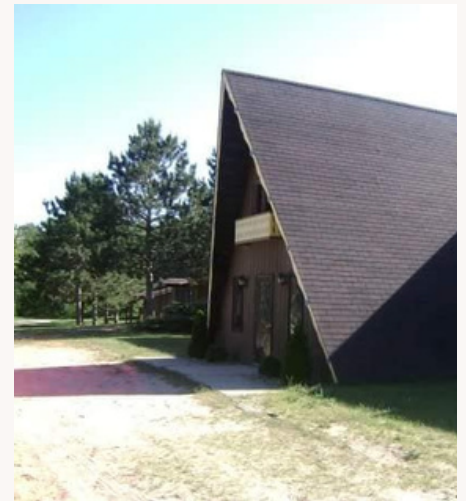
It is an honor and brings joy to me and my family to be asked to come on board and serve God in a way that is close to our hearts through Camping Ministry.

We are in the process of trying to establish a team to help support us in this endeavor.
